

SUPPORT FOR ALL CANDIDATES CHOOSING TO REWRITE THE 2021 APC

Dear APC Candidate

You will have received a communication from SAICA on December 23, where it was indicated that the SAICA Board had resolved that:

- Once SAICA completes the marking of the 1 December 2021 APC, all candidates will be informed of their individual result.
- Once results are released, all APC candidates who took the 1 December 2021 APC will be given the opportunity to rewrite the assessment. The rewrite opportunity is available to all candidates due to the extent of the technical challenges experienced in order to provide the candidates with the opportunity to better demonstrate their competence or improve their competence level from 'Competent' to 'Highly Competent'. Candidates who are successful with the 1 December 2021 APC may elect not to rewrite.
- Candidates who opt to rewrite the 2021 APC will be accorded the higher of the competency levels achieved in the two assessments.
- To participate in the rewrite, candidates must complete a formal registration process and complete all relevant documents pertaining to SAICA's examination rules.
- This rewrite opportunity will be provided at "no examination fee" to candidates.

Whilst we expect that many candidates will have overcome the logistical challenges of the 2021 APC, it is important to note that any APC candidate can choose to rewrite the APC.

Candidates who rewrite the APC will be afforded the higher grading of either the original sitting or the rewrite.

APT will be providing a support programme for any APC candidate who chooses to take the option to rewrite the APC. To support the profession, we have decided to make this program available to all candidates, irrespective of which Professional Programme they completed.

There will be no charge for this support programme.

Provisionally the APT Support Programme for APC Rewriters will run over a four week period with 4 classes covering the "road map and motivation" (mental preparedness), "feedback and reflection on the 2021 APC" and "changes to the eWriting process".

As soon as we have clarity on the dates, the detailed support programme will be made available.
